




Ascending with the First Fruits!

About a hundred years ago, when the first Kibbutzim were set up and people started working the land of Israel once again, the Kibbutzim started to celebrate Shavuot as the Festival of the First Fruits. The farmers, who would see the process of a planted seed sprouting, growing and flourishing, celebrated the Festival of the First Fruits by giving thanks and being joyful for the produce, fruits and settlements that were being established. They started celebrating via parades, ceremonies, songs, dances, and celebrations that take place until this very day in Kibbutzim around Israel.
